Example of Fees

| <u>Treatment</u> | Fee (depending on complexity) |
|--|---|
| Initial Consultation | Free if referred by a dentist. £130 if self referred |
| Assessment and CBCT scan with report | £150 for one jaw £225 for both jaws |
| If needed- Extraction/ removal of single tooth | £260 |
| Implant Placement (one implant) | £2000 |
| Restoration of one zirconia crown | £700 |
| If needed- Bone graft (one area) | £500 |

Am I suitable for dental implants?

Most adults are, but we'll assess your general health, medications, and gum condition first.

Is the procedure painful?

Implant placement is done under local anaesthetic and is well tolerated. Discomfort afterwards is generally mild and manageable.

How long does the process take?

From planning to fitting your final tooth, it typically takes 4–10 months, depending on healing and whether bone grafting is needed. In complex cases this could take longer.

Will I be left with a gap?

We can provide a temporary false tooth while your implant heals. We recommend this for any front teeth so you can continue to smile whilst waiting for the implant crown.

How long do implants last?

Studies show a high success rate of around 95–98% over 10 years. With good home care and regular hygiene visits, implants can last well beyond 10 years.

Will there be any ongoing costs?

Yes, you'll need to attend regular check-ups and hygiene visits at least every 6 months. We also recommend an annual implant review to monitor long-term success which is chargeable.

Do I need to look after the implant once it's healed?

Yes, daily cleaning around the implant is essential, just like natural teeth. We'll advise on the best tools and techniques such as specific brushes and implant floss to help keep the implant healthy.

What if I smoke?

Smoking increases implant failure risk, so we do not recommend having implants unless you are committed to quitting.
